Next Steps

These outcomes will now be at the centre of the meetings/discussions with the Council for Disabled Children (CDC) and members of the Local Authority, Health Professionals, Parent forum groups, SENCOs and families, to co-produce an outcomes framework. This framework will act as a guide for Professionals from: health, social care, education and the voluntary & community sector. All of whom work with children and young people with SEND, to support families and practitioners in Bradford and influence Joint Commissioning and co-production strategies.

The first CDC session is on 24/06/20 where the focus is to develop a shared understanding of the picture 'as is' related to joint commissioning and co-production in Bradford, and where to go next.
