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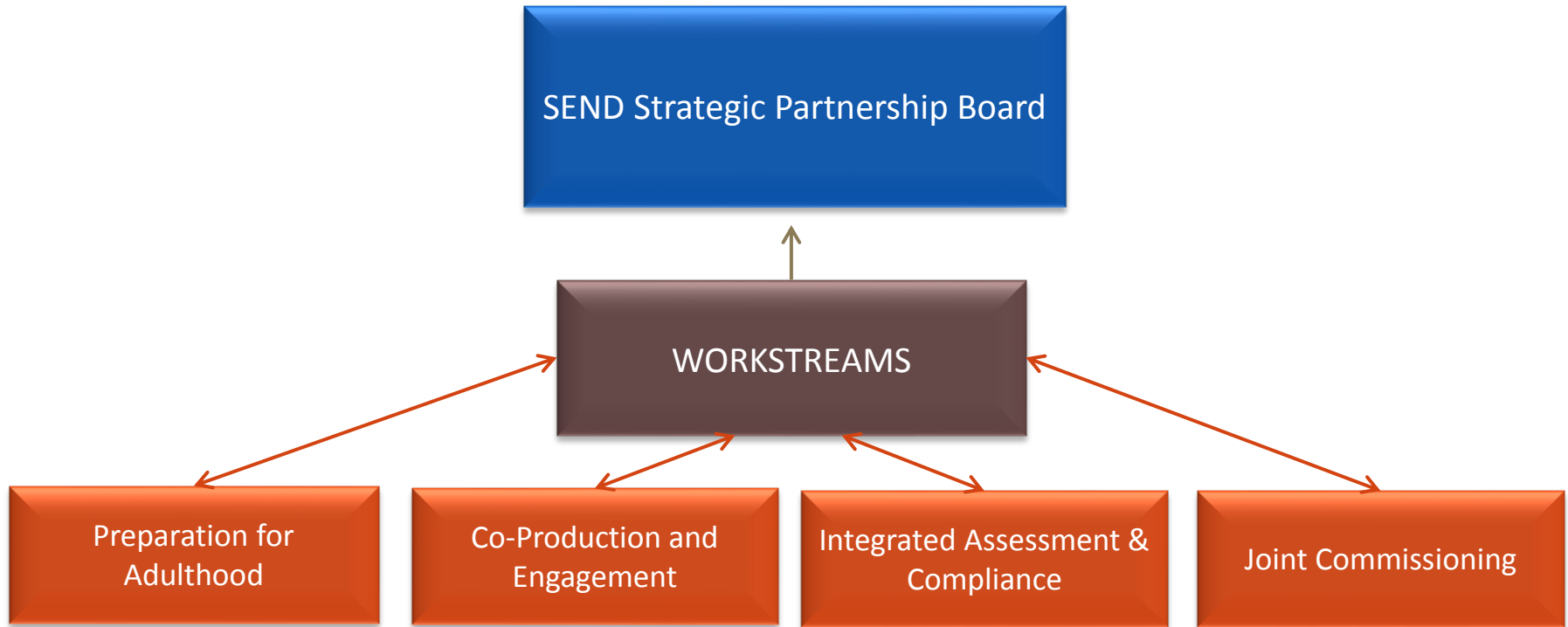

Preparation for Adulthood

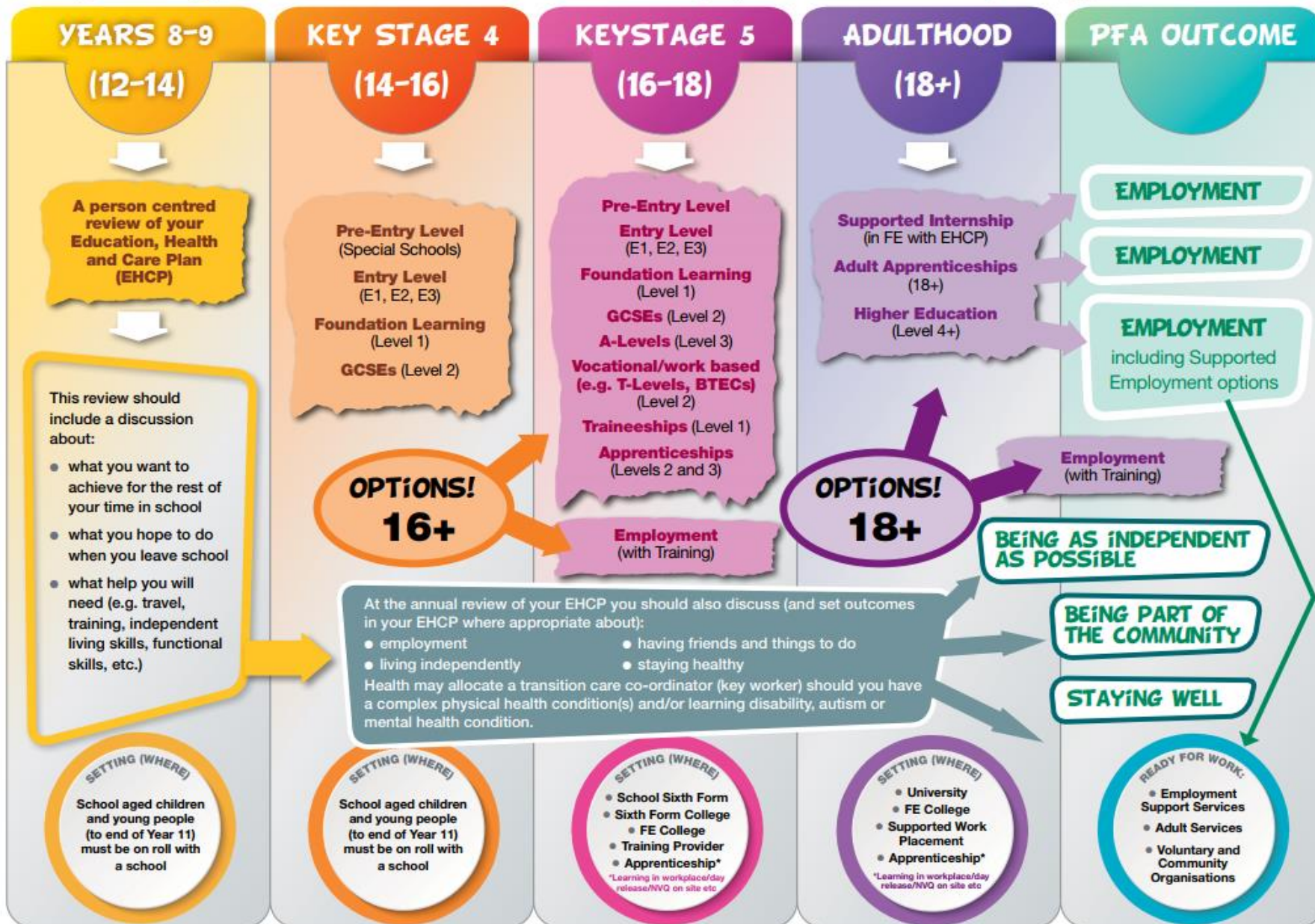
So far:

- ✓ PfA pathway for schools
- ✓ Reviewing use of Personal Budgets
- ✓ Working closely with post-16 establishments and providers like Prospects
- ✓ Increased support and scrutiny of programmes like Project Search

Next steps:

- Reviewing the Annual Review process, especially for transition
- Continue to review effectiveness of supported internships
- Support in reducing NEET figures across Bradford

Preparing for Adulthood Pathway (WITH AN EHCP)



Integrated Assessment and Compliance

So far:

- ✓ Reduced the EHC Assessment backlog
- ✓ Streamlined processes within the SEND Assessment Team
- ✓ Increased capacity
 - ✓ 2019 – 427 EHC plans were produced
 - ✓ 2020 – 429 EHC plans produced so far (12th May)
- ✓ Reviewed funding for EHCPs
- ✓ Following a review of SEND provision, we created an addition 354 places across the District
- ✓ Completed all Y6 and Y11 phase transitions by the statutory deadline

Next steps:

- Annual Reviews
- Quality of EHCPs
- Continue to review number of places of SEND provision
