Introduction

Professionals in Bradford have recently undergone an audit, looking at a number of points and reviewing how their services are best preparing Children and Young People for adulthood. This audit has helped us further understand our working practice in Bradford and where we need to focus efforts moving forward. We are using this opportunity to listen to the parent/carers of young people with SEND preparing for, going through or who have gone through this process not only because we value them but also that we recognise that currently we need to improve the experience parent/carers have.

What is next?

The audit completed by professionals, allowed the Local Area to identify where Bradford is now, in terms of preparing young people with SEND for adulthood and where we want to be. In addition to this we are wanting parent/carers to help us further review how we prepare the Children and Young People of Bradford for adulthood. Therefore we are looking for a Task and Finish group to sit down with the PfA lead coordinator and a number of Parent forums to develop a version of the audit which parents/carers and children/young people will be able to complete, which will be asking for their input on; Children's services, health services and adults social care.
