About the course:

This course supports young people through the transition from education to work. It is a structured work-based programme for students who would benefit from additional support in employment.

Entry requirements:

- You do not need any qualifications.
- Aged 18-24, and have an Education, Health & Care Plan (EHCP).
- Have a positive attitude and enthusiasm to work.
- Be willing to travel independently or to be taught to travel independently.
- Have flexibility around working hours.

Length of course & time commitment per week:

The course takes 1 year to complete.

What you will do:

When in College, you gain a wide range of skills including personal preparation for work, independent travelling, job search skills and effective behaviour at work. You also have a placement/internship where you will work with an employer in partnership with the College.

You also work towards qualifications in maths & English.

Assessment:

The units are assessed both in college and at work. You are assessed throughout your work-placement through regular reviews with your employer.

Your future:

At the end of the Supported Internship Programme, you may be offered paid employment or volunteer work. If you need ongoing support, we work with a number of agencies who can provide the help you need.

Any extra costs:

Most students will not have to pay tuition fees. You will need a small amount of money for study materials, job related equipment/clothing and for travelling to college and work. (Help can sometimes be provided with these costs, please ask).
